



Outline of the Program

SWY Greece Alumni Association is happy to invite you to the first REN reunion organized in Greece from September 22nd to October 1st. Through various activities and local trips we are trying to establish an event that can bring together youth from different parts of the world and have some productive fun while knowing each other better and strengthening the existent network of ex-REN participants.

1. Objectives

The 21st Century Youth Leaders Invitation program brings together youth that have participated in the ship programs in order to further promote friendship, international understanding and inter-cultural learning. Having taken part in the REN program, SWY Greece Alumni Association has realized the importance of the program and we are doing our best to further promote it and bring together participants of different REN programs so as to establish a better connection among the different Alumni Associations and keep the communication alive with a number of activities that can take part through having fun and enjoying the sea and sun in Greece.

SWY Greece Alumni Association is hoping that through the voluntary activities and interaction with the local community the message of peace and friendship can be vivified again bringing the spirit of unified youth to local communities both in Greece and the participating countries.

2. Outline of the program

2-1. Participants

Everyone who is willing to spend a week in Greece can participate. We will enjoy the culture, the environment and the company of young leaders from all around the world while taking part in a number of different activities.

2-2. Duration and Period of the Invitation

The program will last for 10 days, from September 22 (Friday) to October 1 (Sunday), 2006. One can either take part in the whole program or partially in the activities they will choose.

2-3. Schedule

The schedule of the event is shown in Attachment 1.

2-4. Voluntary Activities in Greece

The participants will take part in a number of voluntary activities while interacting with local youth.

3. Expenses

The participants shall bare the cost of the trip including accommodation, meals, transportation, medical and surgical treatments, travel insurance, personal expenses, other expenses incurred for personal need. SWY Greece Alumni Association will do their best to reduce cost to minimum.

In order to better organize your visit SWY Greece Alumni Association can provide the following information regarding costs.

Accommodation fees:	20 € in Athens
Athens tour:	30 € including entrance to archaeological sites, museums and transportation fees.
Meteora trip:	70 € including transportation, accommodation in the area and entrance to archaeological sites and museums.
Santorini island trip:	220 € including transportation, accommodation for two (2) nights and entrance to archaeological sites and museums.
Meals:	about 30 € per day.

* Accommodation cost is per person/per night in a double bedroom.

** Prices might be slightly different and will be exactly defined in the beginning of September

Before coming to Greece, every participant must obtain a Shengen visa (if necessary) and a travel insurance to cover expenses in case of sickness or accidents during his/her stay in Greece.
