Case researched: Preparations for the participation of Brunei Darussalam in SSEAYP

The representatives of BERSATU firstly attended a meeting organized by Japan regarding the SSEAY Programme. Back in Brunei, they reported the outcome of the meeting to the executive members of BERSATU. BERSATU then set up a Secretariat Room at its headquarters to facilitate the preparation work. Three working committees were then established: (1) WC 1 to organize leadership and orientation programme for new participants; (2) WC 2 to organize homestay programme; and (3) WC 3 to organize reunion party on board the Nippon Maru. Each committee also has to prepare press releases on their activities and sent out application forms to prospective foster families.

Lesson learned:

- Efficient organization of the work among the members;
- Transparency and coordination between BERSATU and the government;
- Early preparations of the work are important as this can ensure the smooth running of any events;
- There should be specific contact persons for emergency purposes; and
- There must be a contingency plan for every event.
