REVITALIZING ALUMNI ASSOCIATIONS

WHEREAS, the Cabinet Office of the Government of Japan has gathered exparticipants of the Ship for Southeast Asian Program (SSEAYP) and the Ship for World Youth (SWY) from the Kingdom of Bahrain, Brunei Darussalam, Kingdom of Cambodia, Republic of Costa Rica, Arab Republic of Egypt, Hellenic Republic, Republic of Indonesia, Japan, Lao People's Democratic Republic, Malaysia, United Mexican States, Union of Myanmar, New Zealand, Republic of the Philippines, Republic of Singapore, Solomon Islands, United Republic of Tanzania, Kingdom of Thailand, United States of America, and Socialist Republic of Viet Nam to take part in the 21st Century Renaissance Youth Leaders Invitation Program 2005 held on 6 – 19 October 2005 to discuss Non Profit Organization management with the theme "Towards Further Global Harmonization – Initiation of social contribution activities from these encounter";

WHEREAS, the participants discussed several topics regarding the management of Non Profit Organizations;

WHEREAS, the participants were given situational problems of several Non Profit Organizations in Tokyo and Iwate Prefecture to analyze and find solutions that may be recommended to their respective alumni associations;

WHEREAS, the participants agreed to recommend to their respective alumni associations three (3) major projects: a handbook on Non Profit Organization Management, case studies and a sample of strategic plan on social contribution activity/ies;

WHEREAS, the participants further agreed to recommend for the submission of written report/s on activity/ies undertaken for the revitalization of their respective alumni associations to the Center for International Youth Exchange, Cabinet Office of the Government of Japan;

NOW, THEREFORE, IN VIEW OF ALL THE FOREGOING, the participants of the 21st Century Renaissance Youth Leaders Invitation Program hereby agreed on the following:

- 1. To prepare a handbook on Non Profit Organization Management inclusive of case studies and a sample of strategic plan on social contribution activity.
- 2. To recommend to their respective alumni associations to submit written report/s on activity/ies undertaken for their revitalization before the next scheduled Renaissance Program in 2006 to the Center for International Youth Exchange, Cabinet Office of the Government of Japan.

The 21st Century Renaissance Youth Leaders Invitation Program is scheduled to be held in 2006 at a time to be announced.
